

Working with Fine Cloud License System

Programs: All GEO5, FIN EC, TRUSS4 programs

The aim of this manual is to show the basic work with the new Fine Cloud License system.

From the 2025 edition, all Fine programs are secured by their own cloud-based system. **After purchase of the software, a Fine Account is created for each user. You log in to the account using an email address and a password (a password setup link is provided via email upon license setup).**

These login credentials are used for:

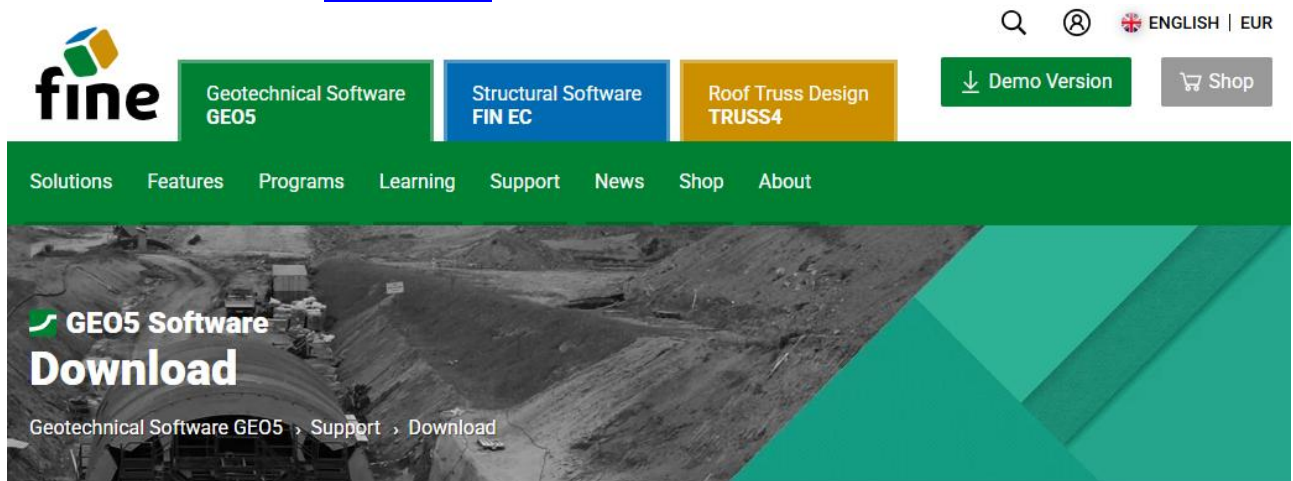
- 1) For installing programs
- 2) For launching programs
- 3) For accessing the license manager, where licenses can, for example, be transferred for offline use
- 4) For accessing the Online Shop, where you can manage users, their permissions, or purchase additional programs

We will describe each of these points in detail.

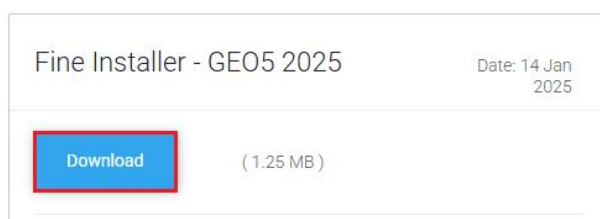
1) Installing Programs

First, download the **Fine Installer**:

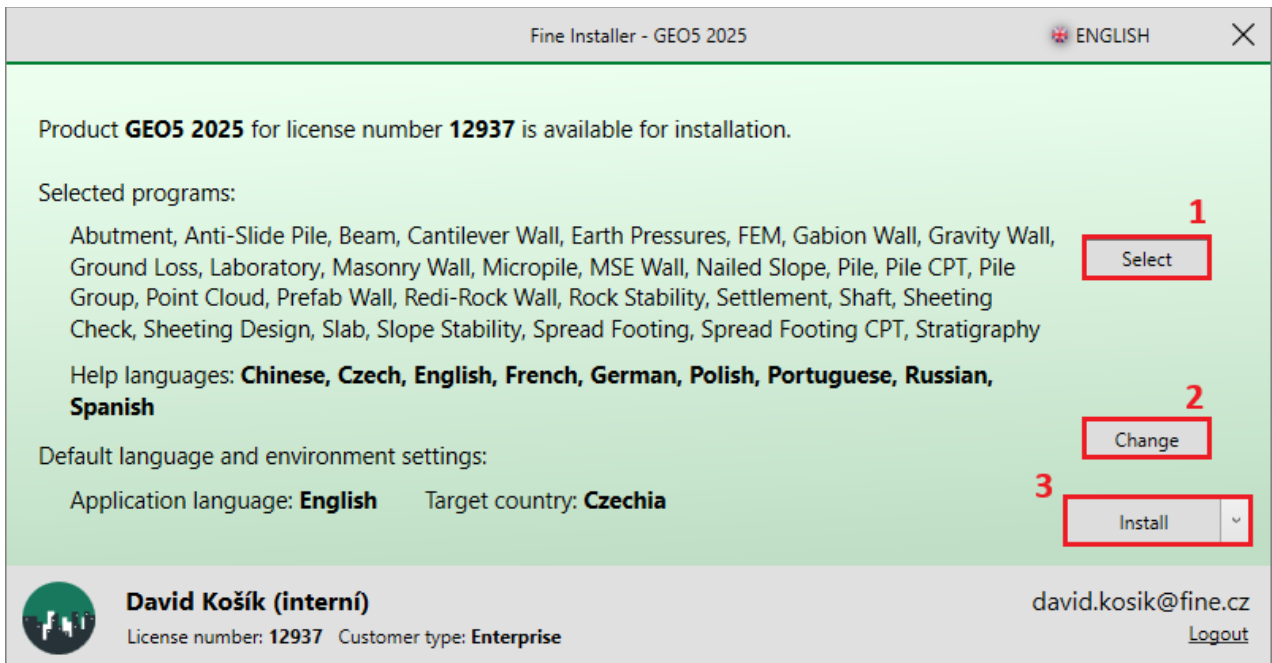


In this manual, we will demonstrate installation for the GEO5 programs.

Run the downloaded file (*FineInstaller_GEO5.exe*) and **enter your login credentials**. If you plan to log in from this computer regularly, you can choose to save the credentials.



After clicking "Log In", a new dialog window appears:

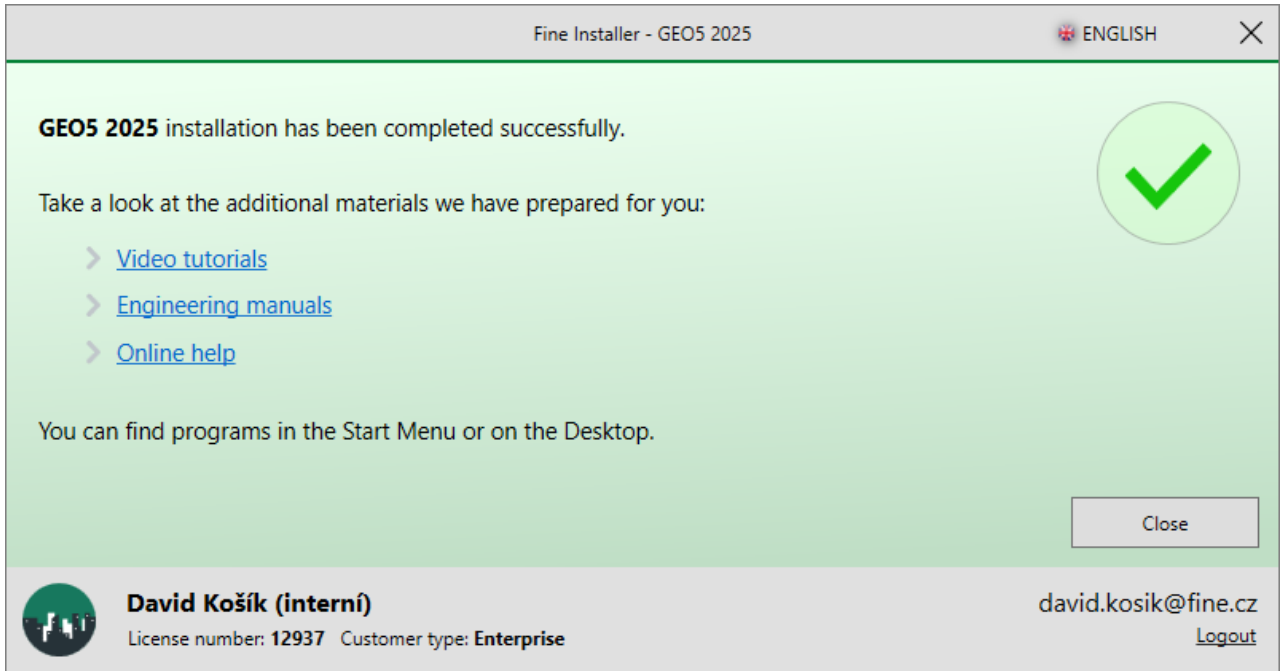


Using the "Select" button (1), you can customize which programs you want to install. By default, all programs are selected. Programs not purchased by the user will be installed as demo versions.

The programs themselves include all language options, but here you can select which languages the help documentation will be installed in.

The **"Change"** button (2) allows us to modify the default language of the application (i.e., the language in which the application starts) and the target country. Both settings can also be changed within the programs via the menu: **Settings – Default language and environment settings**.

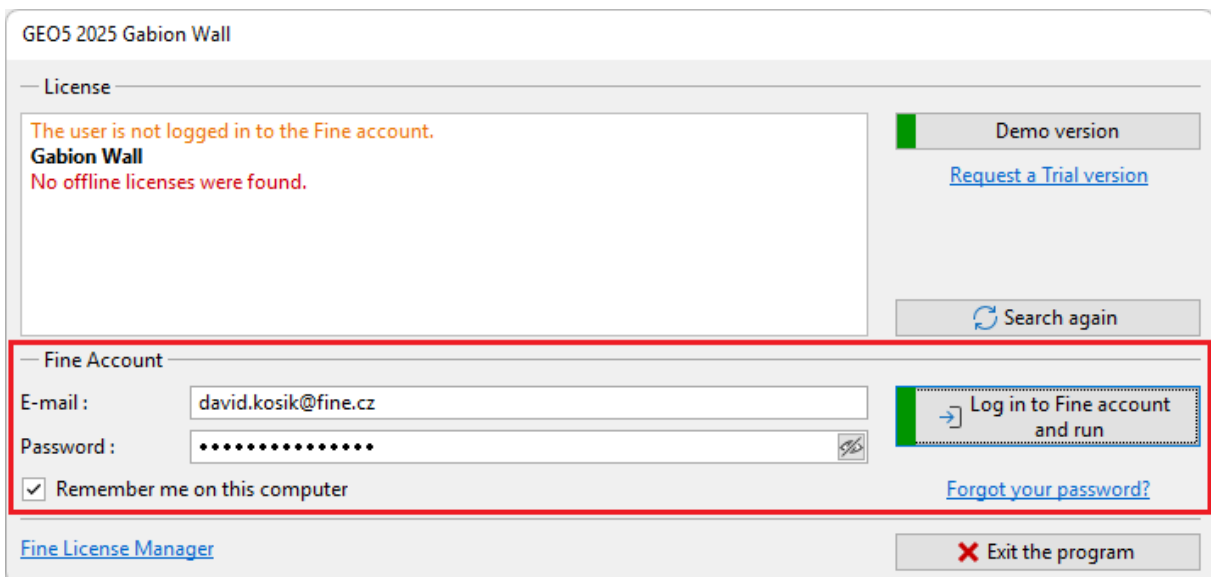
To proceed with installation, click the **"Install"** button (3). Additional options, such as reverting to an older version or selecting 32-bit/64-bit versions, are available under the dropdown arrow.



Once installed successfully, the programs will appear in the "GEO5" folder on your desktop, and you can proceed to launch them.

2) Launching Programs and Accessing Licenses

When you launch any installed program, a login window for available licenses will appear. If you saved your credentials during installation, login will occur automatically. Otherwise, you can save your credentials here as well. Enter your login credentials and click "Log in to Fine Account and run"

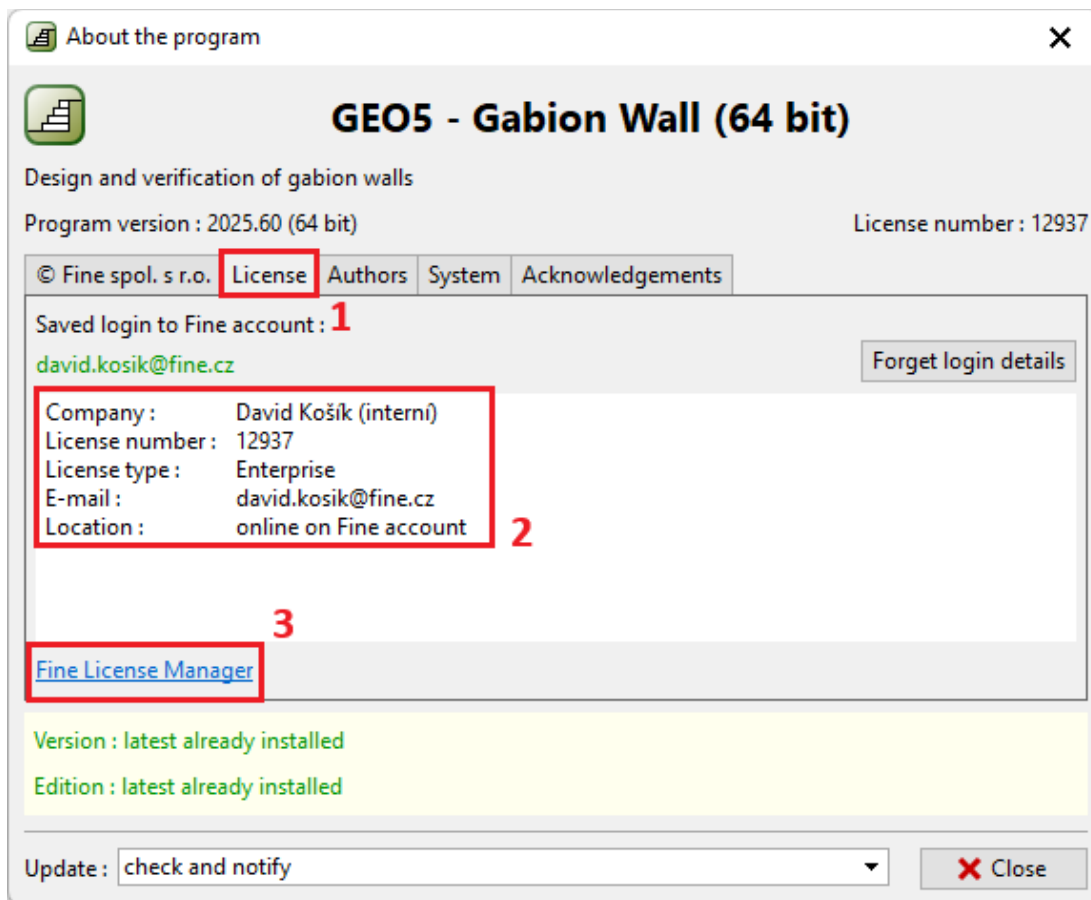


After launching the program, you can check license details in the "About" window, which is available from the [control menu](#) under the "Settings" menu.

Under the "License" tab (1), you'll find information about your license and its storage location (2).

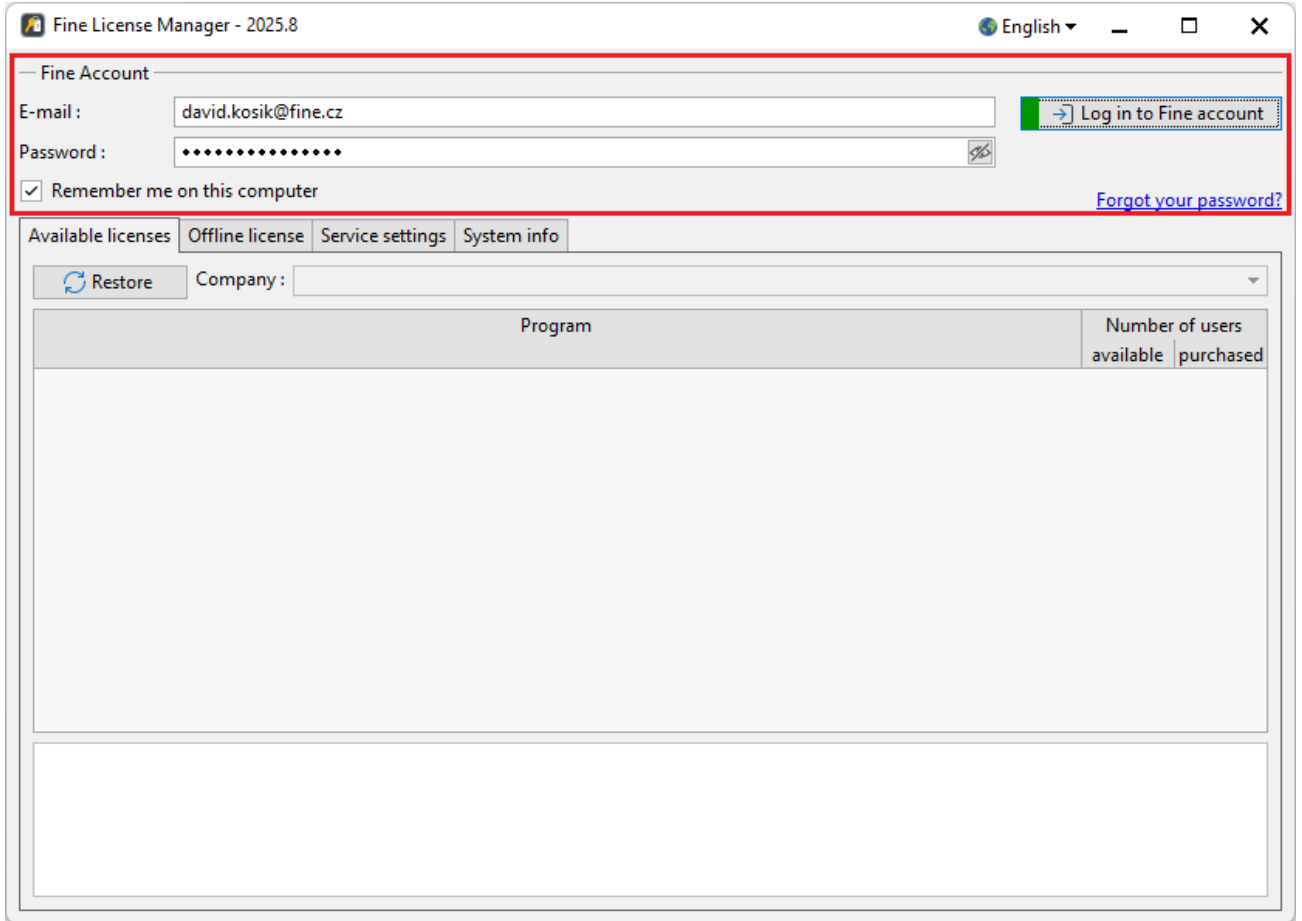
The **license is by default stored online in a Fine Account** - in this case, it is convenient that you can have the programs installed on any number of computers. On the other hand, you must have permanent access to the Internet to use them.

For offline use, licenses can be transferred to a computer or a hardware key using the **Fine License Manager** (3). This process is explained in the next section.



3) License Management in the Fine License Manager

The Fine License Manager opens as a standalone application and works offline. Start by logging in with your credentials.



In the "Offline Licenses" tab, you'll see where your licenses can be transferred (1) — typically the computer you're using (software key). If you've connected a hardware key (hardlock) to your computer, licenses can also be stored on it.

To transfer the licenses, click the "Transfer licenses into a key" button (2).

Transfer of licence to the PC requires TPM 2.0 module.

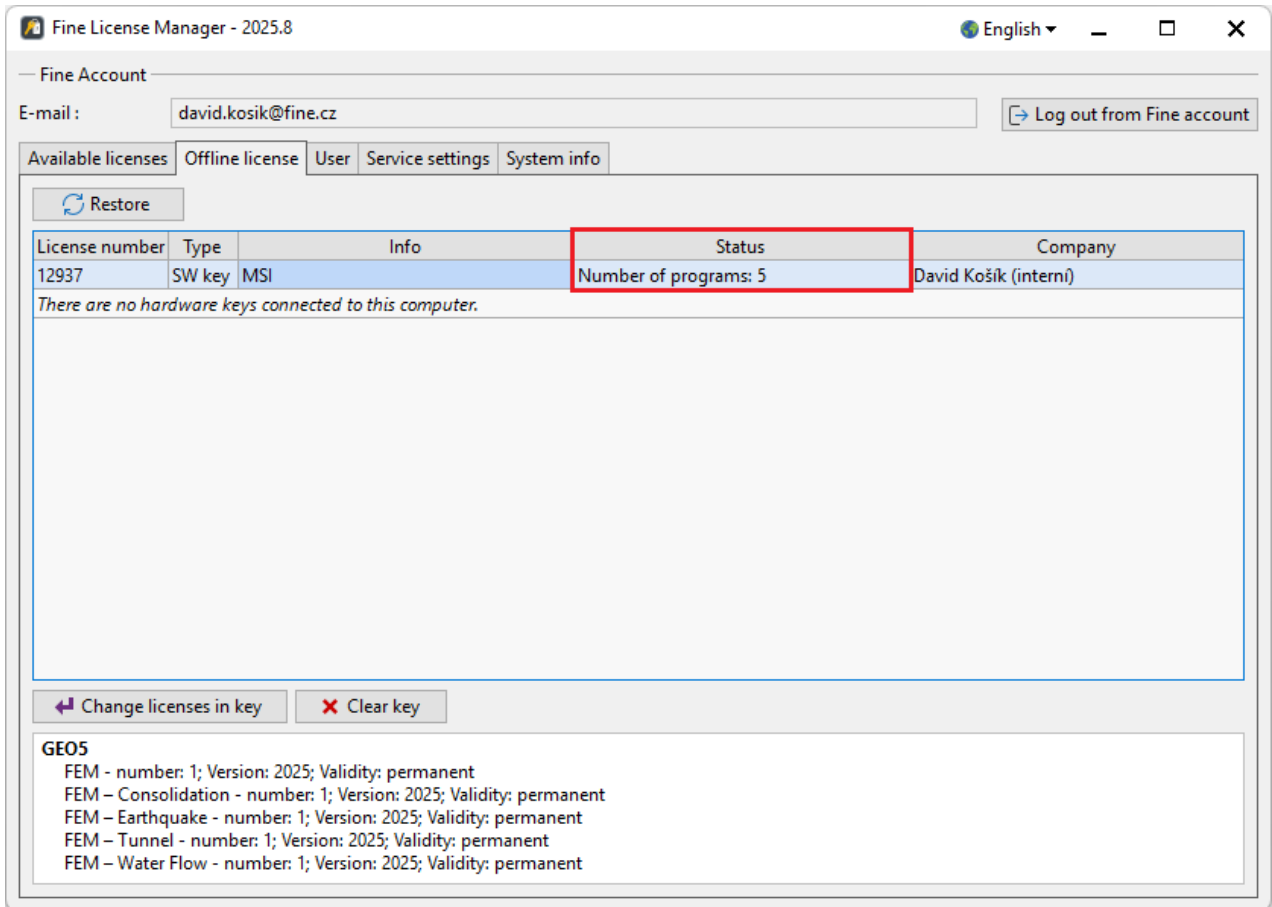

4) User Management in Online Shop

Users with more than one license fall under the Business or Enterprise category. These users can have multiple login accounts, which are managed via the Online Shop on Fine website.

- Access to Software** Ability to use the licensed software.
- License Transfer for Offline Use** Transfer a license to a device for offline use.
- View Other Users** View other users who are currently using the software.
- Licence Takeover** Assume control of a license currently used by another user.
- Purchase of New Software** Buy additional software licenses.
- Use of Saved Payment Card** Pay quickly using stored payment details.
- User Management** Add, remove, or modify user accounts.

The new user can then log in to the programs using their email and password as usual.
